- 1) What is a crosscut saw? (1 Mark)

A cross cut saw has wide alternating bevel teeth perfect for rough cutting on wood grains where tearing out is not important.

- 2) What is a rip cut saw? (1 Mark)

A rip cut saw is an aggressive, push stroke handsaw with sharpened teeth top.

- 3) Differentiate between crosscut saw and rip cut saw? (2 Marks)

Crosscut saw is used to cut large pieces of timber or cuts through a tree across the grain of timber whereas, rip cut saw is specially designed for making cut parallel to the direction of the wood grain.
